Dear Member;

The Tucker WSC water system PWS ID 0010029 has violated the monitoring/reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC) Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to properly disinfect water before distribution, maintain acceptable disinfection residuals within the distribution system, monitor the disinfectant residual at various locations throughout the distribution system, and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ on a quarterly basis.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from microbial contamination.

This violation occurred in the 1st quarter of the monitoring period. Monitoring was completed, however it was not reported in a timely fashion.

We are taking the following actions to address this issue: All further monitoring will be done as per regulations and reported timely.
